Track Your Absentee Ballot

September 13, 2022, Monroe, NC – Absentee-by-mail voters can track the status of their ballots for the November 8 general election through the state’s BallotTrax system at <https://northcarolina.ballottrax.net/voter/>.

Using this service, by-mail voters can track their absentee ballot throughout the voting process, from when it’s sent by the Board of Elections to when the completed ballot is received by election officials. BallotTrax sends a series of alerts to the voter as the ballot moves through the process.

With an account, voters will be able to:

- Log in to view the status of their absentee by-mail request and ballot. This includes confirmation that the Board of elections has received the request, that the ballot has been mailed to the voter, and that the completed ballot has been received by the Board of Elections.
- Learn if their ballot cannot be accepted because of issues such as a missing signature or witness information. If this occurs, the Board of Elections will provide information to the voter on how to correct the issue.
- Sign up for email, text, and/or voice alerts for status updates.

Any voters who signed up for BallotTrax in 2020 or 2021 should still be in the system and will not have to sign up again unless the voter moved to a different county.
